1. Major General Babatunde Ibrahim Alaya was born on 26 December 1971 at Ilorin Kwara State. In 1991, he was admitted into the Nigerian Defence Academic as a member of 43rd Regular Course.
2. In his second year at the Nigerian Defence Academy, he was admitted into the United States Military Academy as a member of Class of 1997 in May 1993.
3. He graduated with honours in the top 10 per cent of his class, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering. He was commissioned Second Lieutenant on 31 May 1997 into the Nigerian Army Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Corps.
4. Major General Alaya has held a number of appointments, some of which include:
 - a. Military Assistant to the Chief of Staff United Nations Mission in Liberia.
 - b. Directing Staff at the prestigious Armed Forces Command and Staff College, Jaji.
 - c. Directing Staff at the Canadian Land Staff Course, Ontario.

 - e. Commanding Officer Guards Brigade Workshop.
 - f. Acting Chief of Staff Headquarters Nigerian Army Electrical and Mechanical Engineers.

 - I. He is currently the Director General, Defence Industries Corporation of Nigeria.

6. Major General Alaya has the following operational experiences:

- a. United Nations Mission in Liberia.
- b. Operation LAFIYADOLE and all subsidiary operations.
- c. Operation HAKIN KAI and all subsidiary operations.

7. Maj Gen Alaya displayed sound engineering knowledge at various times including as Project Manager for the refurbishment of 20 x unserviceable Cobra Armoured Personnel Carriers, 20 x Phantom Mine Resistance Ambush Protected (MRAP) Vehicles and 20 x Scorpion Armoured Personnel Carriers amongst others when the cost of refurbishment submitted by contractors and expatriates was considered too high. He successfully completed the refurbishment at a reasonable cost saving the Nigerian Army millions of United States Dollars in the process. He supervised the complete rebuilding of a number of critical equipment that were burnt as a result of enemy action thereby bringing critical equipment back to life and saving the Army millions of Dollars that would have been used to buy new ones. As Commander Command Engineering Depot, he is responsible for providing the highest level of equipment support to the entire Nigerian Army including complete rebuilding, refurbishment and retrofitting of critical equipment to as good as new condition. He also anchors Research and Development for the Army. His efforts have resulted in production of surveillance drones, suicide drones, Medium Repair and Recovery Vehicles and weapon parts amongst others. He successfully conceptualised, designed and manufactured Vanquisher Armoured Personnel Carriers that the Nigerian Army is currently using for Counter terrorist and counter insurgency operations in North East, North West and South East Nigeria.

Engr. Dr. Umar Buba Bindir, FAEng, FNSE, is a renowned Nigerian Agricultural Engineer, Academic and Senior Public Administrator whose career has been marked by sustained excellence in engineering practice, technology development, and national service. Born on 11th August, 1961 in Yola, the capital of Adamawa State in Northeastern Nigeria, he began his academic journey with the award of a Bachelor of Science degree in Agricultural Technology with First Class Honours from the University of Maiduguri. He subsequently completed the compulsory National Youth Service Corps programme in Benue State.

Driven by a strong interest in machinery design and development, he proceeded to Cranfield University, United Kingdom, where he earned a Master of Science degree in Agricultural Machinery Engineering and later a Doctor of Philosophy degree (PhD) in Agricultural Machinery Design, specializing in Machine Design and Development Engineering. Upon completion of his doctoral studies, Engr. Dr. Bindir joined the academic staff of the Papua New Guinea University of Technology, where he distinguished himself as a scholar and administrator, rising to become Head of the Department of Agricultural Engineering, a position he held from 1992 to 1998.

His professional career extends across academia, research institutes, and public service. He served at the Appropriate Technology and Community Development Institute in Northern Australia and subsequently held several key national appointments in Nigeria, including Director of Operations at the Family Economic Advancement Programme (FEAP) from 1998 to 2000, Director of Monitoring and Management Information Services at the National Poverty Eradication Programme (NAPEP) from 2000 to 2005, Director of Sports at the Federal Ministry of Sports and Social Development from 2005 to 2006, and Director of Technology Acquisition and Assessment at the Federal Ministry of Science and Technology from 2006 to 2009. From 2009 to 2015, he served as Director-General and Chief Executive Officer of the National Office for Technology Acquisition and Promotion (NOTAP). He had also served as the Secretary to the Government of Adamawa State.

Engr. Dr. Bindir is a COREN-registered Engineer, a Chartered Engineer of the European Engineering Council, a Fellow of several professional bodies, and a Council Member of the Nigerian Academy of Engineering. He has been passionately involved in driving the establishment of Nigeria's Science and Technology Parks Programme, pioneered the Africa's Premier Science and Technology Innovation Corridor (APSTICA) in Abuja, and initiated the Technology Story Board (TSB) and the NOTAP–Industry Technology Transfer Fellowship (NITTF) as structured capacity-building strategies for developing Science, Technology and Innovation manpower at both primary and tertiary levels.

In engineering practice, he has designed and produced a once-over groundnut combine harvester suitable for Nigerian farmers, developed animal gear systems for processing agricultural commodities in rural areas, designed and commercialized a coconut de-husking machine for small producers in Australia, the Pacific and Asia, developed a solar water desalination plant for rural communities in the Pacific, a vegetable storage system for rural areas and a 16-bird slaughtering kit for small-scale poultry processors.

Engr. Dr. Umar Buba Bindir's career reflects a rare blend of academic depth, engineering innovation, policy leadership and unwavering commitment to technology-driven development. He is married with children.

Engineer Dr. Babagana Modu Tela, FNSE, FNIMechE was born in Maiduguri, the Borno State Capital and he will be 55 by October, 2026.

EDUCATION:

He attended Aliyaskeri Primary School, Maiduguri from 1979 to 1984. He then proceeded to Government Secondary School Damboa, Borno State between 1985 to 1990 for his Senior Secondary School Certificate.

Engineer Tela continued his quest for higher education at Ramat Polytechnic, Maiduguri where he obtained a National Diploma in Mechanical Engineering from 1992 to 1994 and proceeded to the University of Maiduguri, the Center of Excellence two years later for his bachelor degree in Mechanical Engineering graduating in 2001 with upper credit.

Still in the same prestigious University, between 2010 to 2025, Engineer Tela obtained his Master's Degree in Mechanical Engineering (Energy and Environmental Studies) and later his doctorate degree in Mechanical Engineering (Energy and Environmental Engineering). Within this period, he has also attended Kashim Ibrahim College of Education, Maiduguri for his post graduate diploma in Education as well as Diploma in Computer Office Application and Desktop Publishing form Kontinental Computer College Asaba, Delta State.

Furthermore, the National Chairman has attended many professional courses/workshops home and abroad. He started his career in Borno State Water Corporation as Technical Officer in 1995 and rose to the rank of Principal Engineer (Head of Mechanical Electrical Division). He has also worked in Borno State Rural Water Supply. An ardent scholar, he has written and presented several technical papers at both local and international fora. Despite his tight scheduled in the field of Nuclear Regulation through the Nuclear Regulatory Authority, Dr. Babagana Tela has been very active in research as well as local conferences attendance and publications in reputable journals.

PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Engineer Babagana Modu Tela started his Engineering Career in Borno State Water Corporation as Technical Officer in 1995 and rose to the rank of Principal Engineering (Head of Mechanical Electrical Division). He has also worked in Borno State Rural Water Supply Agency as Head of Mechanical Department from 2004 to 2006. He later jointed Nigerian Nuclear Regulatory Authority in 2006.

Engineer Tela is now the Coordinator of North-East Operational Office Maiduguri overseeing Borno and Yobe States. He is also the Head of Nuclear Safety, Physical Security, Safeguard and Emergency Response of North-East Zone.

Engineer Tela is a Registered COREN Engineer; Fellow, Nigerian Society of Engineers; Fellow Nigerian Institution of Mechanical Engineers; Fellow, Institute of Corporate Administration of Nigeria, Fellow Institution of Management Consultants, member American Society of Mechanical Engineers; member, World Institute of Nuclear Materials Management as well as member World Institute for Nuclear Science. He has received several awards and widely travelled in Nigeria and outside the country.

Engineer Tela has over the years acquired experience in various aspects of Engineering maintenance, project inspection, assessment, supervision, Design and Construction. He has also specialized, certified and expert in Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection in industries and medical facilities which involved inspection and assessment.

He has served the NSE and COREN at different capacities both at the National, Division and Branch levels amongst which include: member, Presidential Committee of NSE-SON Code and Standards on Nuclear Radiation Committee (2025) member, Presidential Committee of NSE DHQ Standards and Evaluation Committee (2025) member Presidential Committee Accreditation (2017) member Presidential Committee of the North-East Development (2018), Vice Chairman, NSE Maiduguri Branch (2018 – 2020) NSE Branch Chairman (2021 – 2023) General Secretary NSE Maiduguri Branch (2016 – 2023), NSE Maiduguri Branch Examiner (2018 – 2021), Inspector, Engineering Regulation and Monitoring (ERM), (2016 – 2020), Chairman, Electoral Committee of NSE Maiduguri AGM (2025).

Engineer Tela is presently National Chairman – Elect, Nigerian Institution of Mechanical Engineers (NIMechE) making him the first Borno State Indigene to occupy this position. He was Deputy National Chairman NIMechE (2024 -2025), National Vice Chairman, NIMechE (2021 to 2023); Borno State Chapter Chairman, Nigerian Institution of Mechanical Engineers, Maiduguri Chapter (2018 -2020).

Engineer Tela is a Board Member, Ramat Polytechnic Maiduguri (2022 to date) Patron, Arewa Peace Ambassador Forum (2022 to date) Patron, Arewa Peace Ambassador Forum (2022 to date) Chairman Board of Trustees, Association of Concern Women Health Workers (2023 to date).

ENGINEERING PROJECTS:

Engineer Modu Tela has made practical contributions to the growth of the Engineering Profession which include Commissioning and Rehabilitation of Maiduguri Water Treatment Plant, participated in the supervision of construction of 20 housing units in twenty seven local government areas in Borno state (2005), participated in the supervision of 1000 housing units in Borno state (2003), Designed Water Reticulation Networks in Abadam and Gubio local government areas in Borno state.

Other projects he has undertaking are supervision of drilling of over 100 boreholes in Borno, Yobe and Abuja (2003 – 2006), designed and developed Air pollution control equipment, Venturi type wet scrubber for Ashaka Cement Company (2014).

Additionally, he carried out safety assessments of Radiotherapy centres of University Teaching Hospital Maiduguri and University Teaching Hospital Gombe in 2010 and 2024 respectively. He has also engaged in the development of municipal solid waste incinerator for Maiduguri power supply and assessment of DHQURS infrastructures (2025).

Inaugural Address By

ENGR. DR. BABAGANA MODU TELA, FNSE, FNIMechE ON THE OCCASION OF HIS INVESTITURE AS THE **17TH NATIONAL CHAIRMAN** OF THE NIGERIAN INSTITUTION OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS, NIMechE

3. Membership Drive and Growth

7. Improvement of Functionality of Secretariat

(c) Structural and Operational Improvements:

Clear Roles and Responsibilities: Establish clear, documented roles for all staff to prevent overlap or gaps in responsibilities; Standardized Procedures: Create and implement standard operating procedures for key tasks to ensure consistency; and Performance Management: Set clear indicators and conduct regular evaluations to ensure high-quality work.

(d) Communication and Interpersonal Skills

(e) Effective Office Environment and Resource Management

(f) Time Management.

8. NIMechE Office Complex

With a renewed effort, our leadership will pursue the issue of a befitting office complex for our Institution because it is absolutely important to
